C = Creation Time The time when the object was created in the directory. This is never available for files. W = Last Write Time This is the time the most recent change was made to the file (e.g. last time the file was opened) This is not available for files. The default is W=Last\_Write. S = File Size This is the size of the file in bytes. This is only available for Active Directory objects. "{mm/dd/yyyy hh:mm:ss tt} / {mm/dd/yyyy hh:mm:ss tt}"

Last\_Write This is the time of the last change to the file. This can be used to determine when a file was last changed (e.g. last time the file was opened). This is the default value if no value is present.
